

A Letter and oral Presentation about your experiences of Injustice and Justice

Injustice and Justice are crucial to every human's life. Please reflect deeply on the impact and role of injustice and justice in your life and write a powerful letter about your experiences and understanding of Injustice and Justice.

You can address your letter to whoever you wish: To the world, to me, to another person, to our class, to God if God is what you believe in... Write to whoever you think will allow you to be the most honest, insightful, and reflective.

The more personal and specific your letters are, the more powerfully they will convey your experience and understanding.

Remember, you will be sharing these letters with the class and putting them up on our class Injustice and Justice website. (You can put an edited version on the website if you don't want parts of your letter available to the public. Anything discussed in our class will be confidential—this will be discussed as a class.)

Be sure to think VERY BROADLY about what injustice and justice are and what they have been for you. Remember, Injustice and Justice take many forms. Trust your own instincts about what has been just and unjust.

Here are some questions to think about:

Please do not answer these questions in order... Use them only as a source of ideas and inspiration and then form a unique structure for your own letter.

- What have been your central experiences of injustice? (THINK BROADLY)
- Have you ever acted unjustly?
- How did you react to these experiences?
- What did these experiences teach you or show you about yourself?
- What do you think "injustice" is? What makes something unjust?
- What have been your central experiences of justice? (THINK BROADLY)
- Have you ever acted in search of justice?
- How did you react to these experiences?
- What did these experiences teach you or show you about yourself?
- What do you think "justice" is? What makes something just?
- What roles do you think justice and injustice play in our world?
- What role do you think justice and injustice will play in your own future?
- Will you fight for justice in any way in your life? How?
- Given that there is so much injustice in our world, where do you find hope?
- Where can our world find hope for its future?
